- I have never been so clueless throughout a class. I started with a motivation to learn, and finished with not knowing what it was actually about. It has nothing to do with the teacher, I just think the course is way to complicated for public health.
- the module has been very overwhelming. There has been way too much material, considering no one on the course comes from a background in economics, therefore it has been impossible to go through all the material and it has been impossible to know what was needed to pass the exam. Furthermore, the teacher has been extremely unpleasant. We have been told off in class for not having prepared, when we had been prepared, but still not understood the what was required of us. Either there is something wrong with the teaching or economics should have been included in the bridging course, because it has been impossible to live up to the teacher's expectations. However, I find it very inappropriate that the teacher has behaved in this manor of being us being told of because we're not 'clever enough' for what she wants.
