What equipment is required to participate?

The lectures are available from the internet, with PowerPoint slides, notes from the teacher and much more. This gives you the opportunity to follow the education live. The quality of the sound and video depend on your technical equipment.

To actively participate in lectures using Adobe Connect you will need the following equipment:

1. A Windows or Mac computer (see Tech specs <u>http://www.adobe.com/products/adobeconnect/tech-specs.html</u>) and a reliable internet connection with a minimum of 2 Mbit download speed. It is possible to use a WIFI connection, but we recommend that you use a cable connection for more stability.

2. A headset with a microphone. For the best sound quality we recommend using a USB-headset. If you wish to participate orally in the lecture, it is a must that you use a headset and not the speakers and microphone in the computer. This is to avoid sound loops.

3. A webcam. If you wish to participate in the group sessions, it is important that your fellow students can see you. The built-in webcam, which there is in most portable computers, is in most cases sufficient.

4. To install the Adobe Connect 9.1 add-in. Before you can participate in an Adobe Connect meeting, it is recommended that you install the Adobe Connect 9.1 add-in. Using the add-in makes it possible for you to adjust some advanced sound settings and to share your screen.
