

The purpose is to give you an opportunity to get a better understanding of each other before you form your study groups.

You are in the initial phase of your university education and you probably do not know many of your fellow students who you are about to form study groups with.

That is why it is a good idea to spend some time presenting yourselves to each other.

Form some groups of 4-5 students.

You must interview each other for 2-5 minutes.

The person to be interviewed stands up first. The other people in the group must now take turns asking the person in the spotlight questions.

Suggestions for questions:

- What would you do if...
- What would you need if...
- How would the world look if...
- What would you say to...
- When is it most fun to...

When the time is up you say thank you for the answers, then it is the next person's turn in the spotlight.



If none of you volunteer as the first person in the spotlight, it could be:

- The one with the most pockets on their clothes
- The tallest
- The one who lives closest to the university
