If you apply as individual, state your name, contact information	
and your study programme.	
If you apply as an association, state the name of the associa-	
tion as well as name and contact information of the coordina-	
tor of the project you are applying for.	
If you apply as a group of students (not an association), state	
the name of all members of the group as well as name and	
contact information of the coordinator of the project you are	
applying for.	
What is the purpose of the association?	
(only to be filled out if you are applying as an association)	
A short description of the purpose of the association.	
If the association is established with the purpose of applying	
for funds from the students' SDG pool, you state that.	
What amount are you applying for?	
State the total amount applied for.	
You must attach a budget to the application, where you spec-	
ify the individual budget items.	
What are you applying for?	
Give a short description of the project, that you are applying	
for. What is it, you have planned and why?	
How do you plan to achieve your goals?	
Give a short description of, how you intend to reach the goals	
of the project. What activities must be completed and how	
Be as precise and factual as possible	
What is the relation to the UN's SDGs?	
State which SDGs your project relates to and how.	
This is where you make your application relevant for a SDG	
pool.	
What is the schedule for the project?	
Start and end dates for the project, and, if possible, planned	
milestones. Dates may coincide if it is a single event.	
Please specify if this is a recurring initiative.	
Which results and effects do you expect?	
Describe the expected results, both in the short and long term.
