Application for **entry into Denmark/cpr number:**

23 September – 11 October 2019

Please do not make any travel plans during this period of time, as you are required to apply for entry into Denmark as soon as the Danish Agency for International Recruitment and Integration (SIRI) has issued your EU registration certificate. The exact date depends on the date on which we will receive the EU registration certificates (this date is not yet fixed but will be communicated in a separate email in due time).
