


Topic overview – publication types

Publication type	Seach tools - Examples
Handbooks overview, definitions of concepts	Summon, Catalogue, Bibliotek.dk
Text books/Books extensive materials within a given subject – a thorough introduction. Often written for a specific target audience, such as students.	
Scientific Articles present latest knowledge/research results, specific subjects (peer-reviewed – independent quality evalutation done by peers). Key literature for researchers.	Summon, Bibliotek.dk (Danish), EBSCO Host (Academic Search Premier, Business Source Complete, International Political Science Abstract), Econlit, Web of Science/Scopus, WARC
Reviews articles, which present an analysis of published research within a specific research field – "state of the art"	Summon, Ebsco Host (Academic Search Premier, Business Source Complete, International Political Science Abstract), Econlit, Web of Science/Scopus
Newspaper articles latest information. Provides an overview of relevant topics. Priority is given to captivating headlines.	Infomedia, NexisUni
Working papers latest scientific research/results, interchanging of ideas	Research Portal Denmark NBER Working Paper
Grey litterature non-commercial published litterature	Internet
Factual databases Numbers, raw data, statistical information but also brief texts, market reports, industry reports, competitor analysis	Orbis, Passport, GlobalData Explorer, Statista, official statistics
