





Good to Know

- Kandidat = Danish for Master
- Cand. Merc. your line of study, Danish for Master of Science in Business
- Cand. Negot. neighboring program (with its own Study Board & rules)
- Study Board: decides about electives, credit transfer from exchange semesters, special exam conditions, plagiarism cases, etc.
- Secretariat of the Study Board: your contact point for all applications
- Profile Responsible: advises the study board in most matters, allocates master theses, seminar topics, internship supervision
- Student advisor: advises on all matters, decides on none
- Studiekontakten: Main contact point for handing in papers, inscribing to courses, signing up for exams, etc. (exam office is part of studiekontakten)
- International office: exchange programs & scholarships (Erasmus)
- Course responsible: senior professor overlooking a course; often not the teacher
