Transition rules

A new curriculum becomes effective on 1 September 2022 and replaces the present curriculum for the Master of Science in Public Health. After this, no enrollment can be made into the program following this curriculum.

Decisions on transition of students from the present curriculum to the 2022 curriculum will be made based on individual assessments. The following principles will be guiding the decision.

Students admitted to the program on 1 September 2021 or earlier, who in E21 and F22 have been enrolled in teaching throughout the 1^{st} semester and 2^{nd} semester and who no later than F23 have passed the entire 1^{st} and 2^{nd} semester, can complete the program on the previous curriculum.

I.e., if a student completes the 1st and 2nd semester on the previous curriculum before E23, they will be able to finish the education on the previous curriculum.

Students admitted to the program on 1 September 2021 or earlier and who in E21 and F22 have not been registered for the entire 1^{st} and 2^{nd} semester or who in F23 have not passed the 1^{st} and 2^{nd} semester are transferred to the 2022 curriculum.

Students who wish to transfer to the 2022 curriculum before the end of F23 can send an application to the Academic Study Board. The Academic Study Board recommend this in cases there the student have been enrolled for classes but may not have participated.

Overview of the Exam attempt after the commencement of the 2022 curriculum. The period for the exam attempts can also be found in the course descriptions.

If a subject is not included in the table below all students have passed the subject and there is no need for more exams.
