

Double Master Degree

If you study at SDU Esbjerg, Environmental and Resources Management, you have a possibility to obtain a double degree: one from SDU in Denmark, and another one from Università degli Studi di Ferrara in Italy. Thus, you have an opportunity to gain two degrees. Besides of experiencing another culture, academic environment, gaining intercultural competences and broadening your professional network, you will expand your possibilities and opportunities for job search in different countries.

What does Double Degree mean?

As a graduate of a double degree programme, you get two separate degrees without prolonging your period of study: one in MSc in Environmental and Resources Management from SDU, and a M.Sc. in Economics, Markets and Management, track Green Economy and Sustainability.

What does it give?

Besides of obtaining two master-degrees, the programme prepares students for the global labour market.

How does it work?

The study programme is composed of courses in social sciences and natural sciences and a master thesis. The first year of the programme takes part at SDU in Esbjerg where all students follow compulsory courses at SDU. During the second-year students move to Italy to follow compulsory courses at Università degli Studi di Ferrara. Courses taken at both universities involved are recognized and replace the elective courses. The master thesis consists of two parts: 10 ECTS provided by SDU and 20 ECTS provided by UNIFE.
