Scholarships and Funds Administered by SDU - Faculty of Engineering

Note: Applies only to students from Odense

The Faculty of Engineering at the University of Southern Denmark administers several funds aimed at enhancing engineering education. These include:

- Engineer Jens Jespersen's Fund
- Maren Elisabeth Rasmussen's Scholarship
- **Ernst B. Sund's Fund** (particularly supports GMM, Production, Mechanical, and Design programs)
- Ellen and Ove Arkil's Fund (only for civil engineering students)

By applying as described below, you will automatically be considered for all relevant funds with a single application. Thus, only one application needs to be submitted.

Eligibility: Scholarships can only be applied for by: Engineering students, both Danish and international, studying at the Faculty of Engineering in Odense. Students from Sønderborg are referred to other funds e.g. through legatbogen.dk.

Application Scenarios: Scholarships can be applied for in the following two cases:

- You have accepted an offer from SDU International for an overseas study stay at one of SDU's partner universities.
- You have entered into a contract with a company abroad for an overseas internship.

Support cannot be applied for ongoing stays, and if your stay is not realized, the scholarship will be forfeited. Note also that the funds do not award scholarships for stays in Europe/Scandinavia, and for these stays, you are referred to scholarships administered by SDU International.

An application does not guarantee receipt of a scholarship, and scholarship amounts are determined in each application round. Awards are made in accordance with the purposes and requirements of the funds.

If the application requires additional information, you will receive an email.

Application Procedure: Applications can only be submitted via the forms in the link below. Only applications received via the link below will be considered.

Application Rounds:

Overseas study stay in the 5th semester of the bachelor's/diploma program or study stay in the 3rd semester of the master's program:

- Application Round 1 for stays in autumn/spring:
 - o Open for applications from March 1 with an application deadline of April 1.
 - APPLY VIA THIS LINK

- o Expect to receive a response at the beginning of June.
- o If you are a diploma engineering student who has switched the overseas internship and overseas study stay, you can submit 2 applications in this round. The first for an internship (autumn) and the second for a study stay (spring). Note that this requires a waiver from the study board.

Internship abroad in the 6th semester of diploma engineering students:

- Application Round 2 for stays in spring:
 - o Open for applications from November 1 with an application deadline of December 1.
 - o APPLY VIA THIS LINK
 - o Expect to receive a response at the beginning of January.

Scholarships are applied for by filling out the form in the above link. Note that you will only receive a response to your scholarship application if you are awarded a scholarship.
