



## I do not show up physically at SDU



- If I **myself** have symptoms of COVID-19 **or** am in doubt if, even though I am vaccinated: Self-isolate and read the Danish Health Authority's guidelines.
- If I **myself** have tested positive for COVID-19: Go into self-isolation and read Danish Health Authority's guidelines.
- If I have been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19: Read the Danish Health Authority's guidelines (please note, information for fully vaccinated people is included).
- If I have been contacted by SDU and been told that I must stay away, e.g. for the above reasons.
- If one or more of the above situations prevent you from attending classes, where attendance is part of the method of assessment, or from attending your exam, please read our FAQ on mitsdu.dk/corona.

**Note:** If you are returning from a trip to a country/region to which the Ministry of Foreign Affairs discourages travel, you must be aware of requirements upon returning home.



## I show up physically at SDU



- If I **do not** have symptoms of COVID-19, **and if I have not been** in close contact to an infected. (If you are vaccinated, please read the Danish Health Authority's guidelines.)
- If I am fully vaccinated **and** without symptoms, even though I have been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19. (You must remember that even though you are fully vaccinated, you must always follow the recommendations and self-isolate and be tested if you experience symptoms of COVID-19.)
- If I have symptoms of COVID-19 but a PCR test confirms that I do not have COVID-19. (However, Danish Health Authority always recommends to stay at home with symptoms of a contagious disease.)
- If I live with someone who has symptoms of COVID-19 but who has not been tested positive. However, you must pay special attention to any symptoms.
- If I have been close to someone who has visited a country to which the Ministry of Foreign Affairs discourages travel. However, you must pay special attention to any symptoms.
- If I have been close to someone who has been close to a person who has tested positive for COVID-19. However, you must pay special attention to any symptoms.
