Framework for study start/master introduction activities in the autumn of 2021

Due to the corona situation, there has been a demand for a common overall framework across SDU in connection with the planning of study start activities for the autumn of 2021. The list below applies to all study start events regardless of whether they are planned and held by associations, student volunteers or administrators.

First of all, everyone who plans study start activities for the autumn of 2021 must be aware that it is uncertain what restrictions will apply at that time. Furthermore, you should be aware that the restrictions may be changed by the authorities at short notice.

Against that background, the following common overall framework applies for study start activities in the autumn of 2021 across SDU:

Activities need to be planned

- ✓ with a focus on the new students' academic as well as social integration
- ✓ with a focus on physical distance and good hygiene
- ✓ in small groups or with a view to scaling/dividing activities further if required by the restrictions in force at the time
- ✓ with a view to considering whether it would be beneficial to conduct parts of the programme outdoors
- ✓ with the possibility of reorganising if planning events with overnight accommodation, as the restrictions in force at the time may make arrangements with overnight accommodation impossible
