

Call for SDU 2021 elections

On 17 September 2021, SDU elections are hereby called to the following bodies:

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| Department Council for RHR: | Election Groups I and II |
| Study Boards: | Election Groups I and III |
| PhD Committees: | Election Groups I and III |

Eligible candidates and eligible voters are:

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| Election Group I | Employed academic staff |
| Election Group III | Students and PhD students |

General conditions regarding the right to vote in SDU elections

Employees belonging to Electoral Group I and II are included in the election list if the following conditions are met: a) the person in question is employed when the election is called and held; b) the employment is for at least 2 years, of which the employment period extends at least 6 months into the term of office; and (c) the employment is at least 15 hours per week. In the case of election to the Board of SDU, PhD students receive the right to vote as academic staff.

Students are admitted to the election list if they are enrolled at the University with a view to completing an overall course of study (Bachelor, Graduate, PhD, or Master's) when the election is called and held. Students enrolled in elective subjects are usually granted voting rights for the study board of their primary subject, unless they wish to assign their voting rights to their elective subject. Single-subject students, guest students and students enrolled in propaedeutic courses or admission courses are not considered to be enrolled in an overall programme.

Election schedule

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| 17 September | The Election Committee announces the holding of the elections |
| 24 September at 12:00 | Deadline for the representatives of the election groups in the collegiate bodies to announce how these should be divided into areas of representation. |
| 28 September | The Election Committee publishes new/changed divisions of areas of representation on the Internet. |
| 4 October at 12:00 | Deadline for requesting the revocation of a division of areas of representation. Deadline for announcing affiliation to one of several possible election groups, one of several election areas or areas of representation. |
| 6 October | Deadline for notification of whether requests for revocation of areas of representation can be met. |
| 21 October | Election lists will be posted. |
| 28 October at 12:00 | Deadline for objection to the published election lists. |
| 3 November | Deadline for the Election Committee to announce the results of any lodged complaints about the election lists. |

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| 10 November at 12:00 | Deadline for submission of candidate lists. Deadline for submitting list designation requests. |
| 17 November | Candidate lists are published. An overview of contested elections, cancellation of elections and uncontested elections is published. |
| 18 November at 12:00 | Cut-off date for submission of notification of entering list and electoral pacts. Any announcements will be published on the same day. |
| 23 November at 12:00 | Deadline for submitting objections to candidate lists as well as list and electoral pacts. |
| 23 November | Ballots (postal votes) are printed and the requisitioned postal voting material is sent out. |
| 23 November at 12:00 | Deadline for ordering postal voting material. |
| 24 November at 9:00 AM | Electronic balloting begins. |
| 25 November at 7:00 PM | Electronic balloting closes. |
| 26 November at 10:00 | Deadline for arrival of postal votes in the Election Committee's mailbox. |
| 26 November | Vote are counted and the election results published. |
| 3 December at 12:00 | Deadline for submitting complaints regarding the elections. |

Any objections, complaints or requests for corrections in election lists, as well as requests for postal voting, etc. must be **submitted in writing (email) to the Election Secretariat.**
