

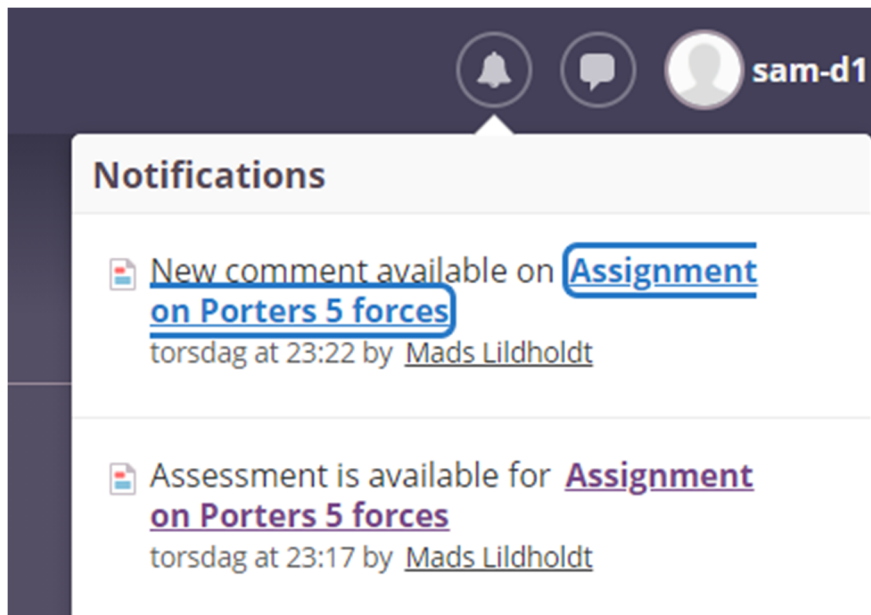
Answering assignments (quizzes, tests, essays)

This tutorial covers where and how to answer assignments in *Itslearning* as a student.

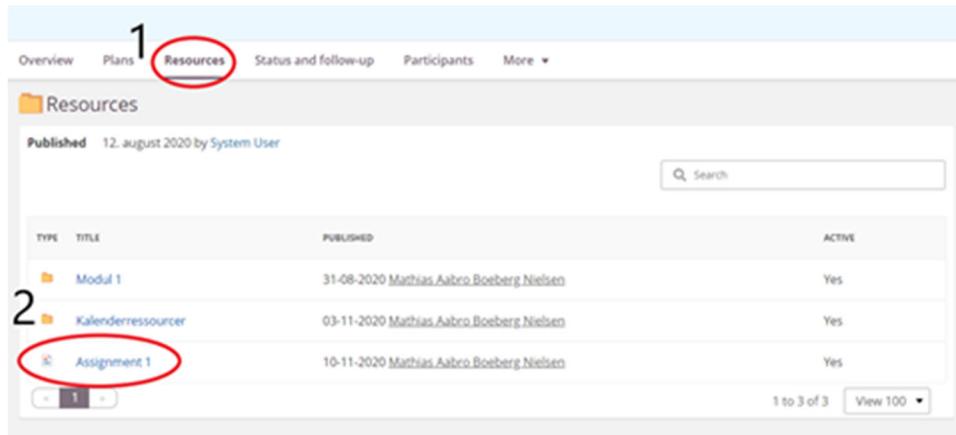
Where do i find an assignment in *Itslearning*?

Assignments in *Itslearning* are accessed directly via the specific course room. If your teacher has created an assignment in his course, you can access it via to paths:

1. Via the front page when loggin on to *Itslearning* - click on the bell icon in the upper right corner to access *Notifications*. From here, you cand find the relevant assignment (in this example: *Assignment on Porters 5 forcers*):



2. You can also access an assignment via the tab *Ressources*, when you have entered the specific course room in *Itslearning*:



1. Click *Ressources*
2. Click the relevant assignment

How do I answer an assignment in my course on *Itslearning*?

When you have accessed the assignment in question, you are directed to the main page for the assignment or test (in this example a multiple choice-test):
