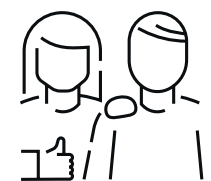
### Respect the choices of others

- Create space for everyone to choose freely
- Respect fellow students' choices and opt-outs
- Respect fellow students' desired social conventions
- Respect a no



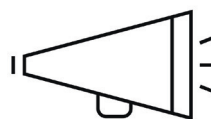
### Show consideration

- Speak considerately to others
- Avoid making negative and derogatory comments about others
- Pay attention to your fellow students



### Be caring

- Meet your fellow students with good intentions
- Support your fellow students when they face adversity
- Show interest and ask your fellow students questions about themselves



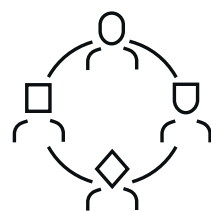
### Say no

- Speak up if others violate your boundaries
- Say it out loud if you feel the tone is becoming negative and derogatory



### Use good judgement

- Pay attention to other people's signals. Your attention and compliments may be unwanted despite your good intentions
- Although consuming alcohol on campus is allowed, alcohol is no excuse for behaving badly
- Pay special attention when entering into new relationships



### Make room for diversity

- Contribute to an environment where it is OK to fail
- Be curious about your fellow students, but respect that they don't necessarily want to talk to you about everything
