- PsycInfo is the largest and most comprehensive psychological bibliography.
- A scholarly psychology database covering periodicals, dissertations, reports, books and selected chapters.

## Subject Search

Searching in PsycInfo should include the use of the Thesaurus. It is activated by entering a term, one at a time, while ticking the box "Map Term to Subject Heading".

Entering the Thesaurus opens the use of explosion (inclusion of subordinated subject headings (subheadings)). This feature is activated by ticking the box "Explode" in the Subject Headings screen. Press 'Continue' to perform the search.

## Free text Searching

Remove tick at Map Term to Subject Heading before searching. Beware searching for 2 words in order, will retrieve the phrase e.g., Major depression.

## Truncation

The truncation characters are ? or \*

Using \* will retrieve all possible suffix variations. ? substitutes none ore a single character e.g.. Colo?r
